What is a luminaria?

Luminarias are bags that are sold and decorated with the name and message to honor lives touched by cancer. They can be dedicated in memory of a loved one lost, in honor of someone currently battling, or anyone who's overcome it. These bags (a white paper lunch size bag) are displayed at the event and have a tea light inside that is lit during a special Luminaria Ceremony, as part of the Relay For Life event.

What is the Luminaria Ceremony?

After dark, Relay participants share an emotional moment when each Luminaria is lit in honor and remembrance of a life touched by cancer. The objective of the ceremony is to provide participants with an experience that carries them on a journey that reflects their personal experience, collectively grieves each loss from cancer, and gives participants the ability to see hope for the future. Bags are lit, and names of the honored and memorialized are read.
